MEADOW WOOD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Dear Resident,

The City of Plymouth is conducting an improvement project in the rear yards and roads of the Meadowood subdivision and reduce pollution flowing into Gleason Lake. The project was publicly bid in September 2020 and the contract was awarded Pember Companies, Inc. of Menomonie, WI. Construction for this project was broken up into 2 phases, with Phase I being completed in the Fall of 2020.

Phase 2 of construction is anticipated to start May 3rd, 2021 and will include installation of new storm sewer within the 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue North roadway. Restoration items from Phase I will also be completed.

To complete the work, 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed to through traffic from Troy Lane to Shadyview Lane. A signed detour will be established utilizing Troy Lane and Shadyview Lane.
