The City of Plymouth will be making improvements to Vicksburg Lane during the 2022 construction season. The attached map illustrates the area that is proposed to receive work per the City's Capital Improvement Plan. The City will host neighborhood meetings to provide information on the proposed improvements for Vicksburg Lane.
