We'll use oil paint to learn techniques on both wood and canvas boards. Recommended supply list provided prior to class.

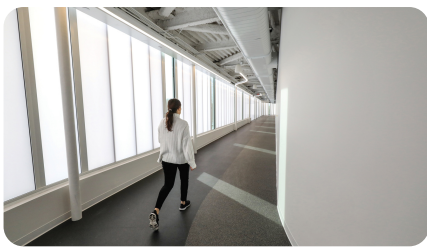
