Welcome to Our Second Newsletter and Schedule in 2023

In spite of some quite cool and fairly hot weather to start our 2023 season, ride turn out has been great with 49 Lite and Regular pedalers riding around the lakes. Other memorable locations -- the big pencil along Lake of the Isles and Coffee at the Turtle Bread Company. And our own Orange Brigade.







Now we're looking for some just right weather for our seven second schedule rides.

Both the Lites and the Regulars have the same start location four times on the second schedule, including a new start location – Shady Oak Beach – on May 31. See the ride schedules for a links to this location. On July 5 "Holiday Week", the Lites and Regs will both start at Triangle Park and ride to Minnehaha Park. Regs will leave first and Lites will follow. On June 7, the Regulars have an out-of-town ride to Hastings.

On the second schedule, the Regulars will continue to do a pre ride on Mondays in addition to the Wednesday ride. The ride location and the starting time will be the same for both rides. The pre ride may be a bit faster, and more exploratory for trail closures and alternate routes. The Lite rides will ride on Wednesday, only.

Bike Maintenance

Now that we've put a few miles on our bikes, let's make sure they stay in tip-top conditions. Clean your bike (we've already been on some soft limestone trails), lubricate you drivetrain, inspect your tires, check your breaks and bring along a spare inner tube. If in doubt take your bike to a shop.

Our announcement line is 763-509-5275. On ride days, it will be updated by 7:30 a.m. if the ride is cancelled. Call the info line if in doubt about the weather so you don't drive to a ride and find it was cancelled.
