

What Is Bare Root?

There are three ways to buy a tree; bare root, containerized, and B&B (balled and burlapped).



Bare root, Containerized, & B&B (balled & burlapped)

Some Advantages Of Bare Root Are:

- Price per tree is less than $\frac{1}{2}$ the price of B&B more easily transported
- You bring home up to 200% more roots than you get with B&B
- A visible root system allows for detection/correction of flaws and better enables you to plant the tree at the proper depth.

It is best to plant bare-root trees immediately, in order to keep the fragile roots from drying out. If you can't plant because of weather or soil conditions, store the trees in a cool place and keep the roots moist.
